

HOUSE No. 361.

Bill accompanying the petition of Thaddeus C. Defriez and others for legislation to authorize the selectmen of the town of Nantucket to regulate or prohibit the use of automobiles and motor vehicles in that town. Roads and Bridges. January 16.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Nantucket to exclude Automobiles and Motor Cycles from its Highways.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. So much of section one of chapter three
2 hundred and sixty-six of the acts of the year nineteen
3 hundred and five, as amended by section nine of chapter
4 four hundred and twelve of the acts of the year nineteen
5 hundred and six, as authorizes a filing of a protest to the
6 Massachusetts highway commission, shall not apply to
7 the town of Nantucket; and the selectmen of that town
8 are hereby authorized to exclude automobiles and motor
9 cycles from the highways of the town, and a regulation
10 to that effect shall be final and conclusive.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
