AN ACT

Relative to the Salaries of Jailers and Masters of
Houses of Correction.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section nineteen of chapter twenty-
2 four of the Revised Laws of the Commonwealth is
3 hereby amended by striking out the word " one," in
4 said section, and inserting in place thereof the word:
5 — *two*, — so as to read as follows: — *Section 19.* A
6 sheriff who personally performs the duties of jailer
7 or master of the house of correction may receive, in
8 addition to his salary as sheriff, the compensation
9 established by law for such services, but not more
10 than *two* thousand dollars a year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
