Bill accompanying the petition of Frank L. Dean for legislation to establish the salary of the private secretary to the Governor of the Commonwealth. Public Service. January 17.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Private Secretary to the Governor of the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section five of chapter four of the Re-
2 vised Laws of Massachusetts is hereby amended by strik-
3 ing out, in the third line thereof, the words "twenty-five
4 hundred dollars," and inserting in place thereof the
5 words:— *thirty-five hundred dollars*,— so as to read
6 as follows:—

7 *Section 5.* The governor may appoint a private sec-
8 retary who shall hold office during the pleasure of the
9 governor, and shall receive an annual salary of *thirty-*
10 *five hundred dollars.*

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
