## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

### AN ACT

Relative to the Salaries of the Justice and Clerk of the Central District Court of Northern Essex.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Class E of section one of chapter four  
2 hundred and fifty-three of the acts of the year nineteen  
3 hundred and four, as amended by section one of chapter  
4 three hundred and twenty-five of the acts of the year nine-  
5 teen hundred and six, is hereby further amended by strik-  
6 ing out the word "and," in the fourth line, and by in-  
7 serting after the word "Chelsea," in the fifth line, the  
8 words: — and the central district court of northern Essex,  
9 — so as to read as follows: — Class E. Courts whose

10 judicial districts have a population of from fifty thousand  
11 to sixty thousand, to wit, the district court of East Nor-  
12 folk, the district court of East Boston, the police court of  
13 Brockton, the police court of Chelsea, and the central  
14 district court of northern Essex; salaries:—Justice,  
15 twenty-five hundred dollars; clerk, fifteen hundred dol-  
16 lars.

1 SECTION 2. Class F of said section, as amended by  
2 section two of chapter three hundred and twenty-five of  
3 the acts of the year nineteen hundred and six, and section  
4 one of chapter one hundred and twenty-eight of the acts  
5 of the year nineteen hundred and seven, is hereby fur-  
6 ther amended by striking out the words “the central dis-  
7 trict court of northern Essex,” in the fifth line,—so as  
8 to read as follows:—Class F. Courts whose judicial  
9 districts have a population of from thirty thousand to  
10 fifty thousand, to wit, the district court of Hampshire,  
11 the police court of Holyoke, the district court of first  
12 Bristol, the municipal court of the Charlestown district,  
13 the district court of northern Norfolk, the municipal  
14 court of the West Roxbury district, the second district  
15 court of eastern Middlesex, the fourth district court of  
16 eastern Middlesex, the police court of Newton, the dis-  
17 trict court of eastern Essex, the police court of Fitchburg,  
18 the second district court of Plymouth and the district  
19 court of Franklin; salaries:—Justice, two thousand dol-  
20 lars; clerk, twelve hundred dollars.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage,  
2 but the salaries of the justice and clerk of the central  
3 district court of northern Essex, herein established, shall  
4 be allowed and paid from the first day of January in the  
5 current year.
