Resolve accompanying the petition of the Draper Hall Stable Company for reimbursement for injuries to a horse while in the service of the militia. Military Affairs. January 21.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

RESOLVE

To provide for Reimbursing the Draper Hall Stable Company for the Loss of a Horse Injured in the Service of the Militia.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth such sum as may be
3 necessary for the purpose of reimbursing Draper Hall
4 Stable Company for the loss of a horse due to injuries
5 received, or illness contracted, in camp at Hingham in
6 said Commonwealth on or about August ten, nineteen
7 hundred and seven, while said horse was being used by
8 the militia of this Commonwealth, namely, the First
9 Corps of Cadets, for service at its summer camp, said
10 sum to be expended under the direction of the adjutant-
11 general, but not to exceed the sum of one hundred and
12 fifty dollars.
