AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses in
the Department of the Sergeant-at-Arms.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned are
2 appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury of the
3 Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue, for the
4 purposes specified, for the fiscal year ending on the
5 thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and
6 eight, to wit:—

7 For the salary of the chief engineer and other
8 employees in the engineer's department, a sum not
9 exceeding twenty-eight thousand nine hundred and
10 forty dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 10, sect. 9; Acts
11 1906, chap. 232.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$28,940.)

12 For the salaries of the watchmen and assistant
13 watchmen at the state house, a sum not exceeding
14 fourteen thousand and six hundred dollars. [Rev.
15 Laws, chap. 10, sect. 9; Acts 1903, chap. 455.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$14,600.)

16 For the salaries of the sergeant-at-arms' messen-

17 gers, porters and office boy at the state house, a sum
18 not exceeding eleven thousand and sixty dollars.
19 [Rev. Laws, chap. 10; Acts 1907, chaps. 359 and
20 384.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$11,308.34.)

21 For rent of telephones and expenses in connection
22 therewith at the state house, a sum not exceeding
23 seven thousand dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 10.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$7,280.)

24 For heat, light and power at the state house, in-
25 cluding coal, water, gas and removal of ashes, a sum
26 not exceeding thirty-five thousand dollars. [Rev.
27 Laws, chap. 10.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$35,000.)

28 For the care of the state house and grounds, in-
29 cluding repairs, furniture and repairs thereof, and
30 such expenses as may be necessary at the various
31 buildings now occupied by state departments, a sum
32 not exceeding twenty-four thousand dollars. [Rev.
33 Laws, chap. 10.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$24,000.)

34 For new furniture and fixtures, a sum not exceed-
35 ing six thousand dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 10.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$10,000.)

36 For the salary of the state house matron, a sum
37 not exceeding eight hundred dollars. [Rev. Laws,
38 chap. 10.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$800.)

39 For the salary of the state house carpenter, the
40 sum of fourteen hundred dollars. [Rev. Laws,
41 chap. 10.]

(Appropriation 1907, \$1,400.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
