Bill accompanying the petition of Charles A. Dean for legislation relative to the membership of State committees of political parties. Election Laws. January 22.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

AN ACT

Relative to the Membership of State Committees of Political Parties.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section eighty of chapter eleven of the revised laws is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "of," in
3 the fourth line, the words:—not more than twenty mem-
4 bers at large, who shall be elected at the state convention
5 of each party called to nominate candidates for governor
6 and other state officers, or by the elected district mem-
7 bers at their meeting for organization or succeeding
8 meetings; and by adding after the word "election," in
9 the eighth line, the words:—The said committee shall
10 constitute a corporation.
