Bill accompanying the petition of Andrew McGlynn for legislation to provide that all fines for violation of game laws shall be paid into the treasury of the Commonwealth. Fisheries and Game. January 22.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

AN ACT

To provide that Fines for Violation of the Game Laws shall go into the Treasury of the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. All fines recovered for violation of the
2 fish and game laws shall hereafter be paid into the treas-
3 ury of the Commonwealth, and no part thereof shall be
4 paid to any warden, deputy warden or other officer.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
