Bill accompanying the petition of Ernest H. Pierce for legislation to prohibit the issuance of licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquors in territories adjoining no-license cities and towns. Liquor Law. January 22.

AN ACT

Prohibiting the Issuance of Licenses for the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors in Certain Territories adjacent to No-license Cities and Towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The issuance of licenses for the sale of
2 intoxicating liquors by the duly constituted authorities
3 having in charge the issuance of such licenses in cities
4 and towns voting in favor of license, is hereby further
5 restricted as follows: No license for the sale of intoxi-
6 cating liquors shall be issued to be used in any build-
7 ing within half a mile of the boundary line of any city
8 or town voting against liquor licenses.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
