### AN ACT

Relative to Special Enumerations of the Inhabitants of Cities  
and Towns.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section third of chapter one hundred and  
2 seven of the Revised Laws, providing for special enumera-  
3 tion by the bureau of statistics of labor of the inhabitants  
4 of cities and towns, is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
