Bill accompanying the petition of William H. Oakes and others for legislation to authorize the Waban Church Corporation to convey its property to the Parish of the Good Shepherd, and for other purposes. Parishes and Religious Societies. March 17.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

AN ACT

Relative to the Waban Church Corporation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Waban Church Corporation of
2 Newton and William C. Strong and Amasa S.
3 Barnes, trustees, are hereby authorized to sell and
4 convey to the Parish of the Good Shepherd, or such
5 trustees as it may appoint, the real estate and prop-
6 erty now held by them or either of them for pur-
7 poses of religious worship upon such terms as may
8 be agreed upon.

1 SECTION 2. Said Waban Church Corporation is
2 hereby authorized to transfer to the Union Church

3 Society of Waban, or to such trustees as it shall
4 appoint, any property which it may receive under
5 the provisions of the preceding section upon such
6 terms as may be agreed upon.

1 SECTION 3. Upon the completion of the tran-
2 sactions recited in the preceding sections the Waban
3 Church Corporation shall be dissolved.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
