RESOLVE

To provide for the Dredging of an Anchorage Basin in Hingham Harbor.

1 *Resolved*, That the board of harbor and land commis-
2 sioners is hereby authorized and directed to dredge an
3 anchorage basin at the head of Hingham harbor, to the
4 depth of six feet at mean low water, and they may expend
5 in carrying out the provisions of this resolve a sum not
6 exceeding five thousand dollars.
