AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Maintenance of Industrial Schools in Certain Cities of the Commonwealth.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding six thousand
2 dollars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of
3 the treasury of the Commonwealth, from the ordi-
4 nary revenue, for meeting the state's proportion of
5 the cost of maintenance of independent industrial
6 schools in certain cities under the authority of chap-
7 ter five hundred and five of the acts of the year
8 nineteen hundred and six; payments under this act
9 to be made only upon evidence satisfactory to the
10 auditor of the Commonwealth that the provisions
11 of law have been complied with.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
