

SENATE No. 6.

To accompany the petition of Amos W. Shepard and another for the construction of a boulevard from Broadway park in the city of Somerville to the Charles river. Metropolitan Affairs.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

AN ACT

To provide for the Construction of a Boulevard from Broadway Park in the City of Somerville to the Charles River.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commission
2 may, for the purpose of constructing parkways and
3 boulevards under the authority of chapter two hun-
4 dred and eighty-eight of the acts of the year eight-
5 een hundred and ninety-four, and of any acts in
6 amendment thereof or in addition thereto, including
7 chapter five hundred and fifty of the acts of the
8 year eighteen hundred and ninety-six, expend an
9 additional sum of six hundred thousand dollars.

10 The said amount shall be used for the construction
11 of a boulevard from Broadway park in the city of
12 Somerville to Charles river at or near Cottage
13 Farm, or such other point as may be deemed ad-
14 visable.

1 SECTION 2. To meet expenses incurred under au-
2 thority of this act the treasurer and receiver-
3 general shall issue scrip or certificates of indebted-
4 ness, or bonds, to the said amount of six hundred
5 thousand dollars, as an addition to the metropolitan
6 parks loan, series two. The sinking fund already
7 established by law shall also be maintained for the
8 purpose of extinguishing scrip, certificates or bonds
9 issued under the authority of this act. Any pre-
10 mium realized on the sale of such scrip or certifi-
11 cates or bonds shall be applied to the payment of
12 the interest on the loan hereby authorized, as it
13 accrues. Said scrip or certificates of indebtedness,
14 or bonds, shall be issued and said sinking fund as-
15 sessed and collected in accordance with the provi-
16 sions of said chapters two hundred and eighty-eight
17 and five hundred and fifty.

1 SECTION 3. All work authorized by this act shall
2 be done in accordance with the provisions of section
3 two of chapter four hundred and eighty-one of the
4 acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
