

3. The date of its last preceding annual meeting.

4. The names and addresses of all the officers and directors, or officers having the powers of directors, of the corporation, and the date at which the term of office of each expires.

The state secretary shall examine such certificate, and if he finds that it conforms to the requirements of this chapter he shall, upon payment of a fee of two dollars, file the same in his office. Fee.

If the corporation fails to submit its certificate for two successive years, the state secretary shall give notice thereof by mail, postage prepaid, to such corporation in default. Failure of such corporation to submit the required certificates within ninety days after the notice of default has been given shall be sufficient cause for the revocation of its charter by the state secretary. Revocation of charter upon failure to file return, authorized.

This section shall not apply to a church or religious organization, a non-profit school or college, a corporation organized prior to January first, nineteen hundred and twenty-three, under the laws of this commonwealth and having as part of its name the name of a political party as defined by law, or a charitable hospital. *Approved May 22, 1956.*

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE WATER SUPPLY FOR THE BRISTOL COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SCHOOL. *Chap.391*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 392 of the acts of 1941 is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 2 and 3, the words "South Dighton Fire and Water District" and inserting in place thereof the words: — Dighton Water District.

SECTION 2. The acts of the trustees of the Bristol County Agricultural School in selling water for domestic use prior to the effective date of this act are hereby validated.

SECTION 3. The trustees of the Bristol County Agricultural School are hereby authorized to continue or extend the sale of water for domestic use to owners of property abutting the school water mains in cases where such owners cannot be served by a public water supply.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT EXTENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE LYNNFIELD WATER DISTRICT. *Chap.392*

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Chapter 445 of the acts of 1924 is hereby amended by inserting after section 1A, inserted by section 1 of chapter 69 of the acts of 1953, the following section: — *Section 1B.* The boundaries of the said Lynnfield Water District as established by section one and extended by section one A are hereby further extended to include the terri-
