

SENATE No. 107.

To accompany the petition of J. Frank O'Hare for legislation relative to the order of names of candidates for aldermen on the official ballot, especially in the city of Boston. Election Laws.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

AN ACT

Relative to the Order of the Names of Candidates for Aldermen in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. In the city of Boston the names of can-
2 didates for aldermen on the official ballot at elections
3 shall be arranged in the first place by districts, each dis-
4 trict being designated at the head of the list of candidates
5 belonging to that district, and the names thus arranged
6 by districts shall also be arranged alphabetically under
7 the head of each district.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
