To accompany the petition of Frank J. Linehan for legislation relative to the service of writs in the county of Suffolk. . Joint Judiciary.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

AN ACT

Relative to the Service of Writs in the County of Suffolk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Sheriffs and their deputies of any
2 other county in the Commonwealth are hereby au-
3 thorized to serve writs in the county of Suffolk.

1 SECTION 2. Constables duly appointed and quali-
2 fied to serve writs in the county of Suffolk are
3 hereby authorized to serve writs in said county
4 where the damages do not exceed one thousand dol-
5 lars.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
