

SENATE No. 194.

To accompany the petition of Albert J. Connell for legislation relative to fees and the service of legal processes. Legal Affairs.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

AN ACT

Relative to Fees and Service of Legal Processes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The fees for the service of a divorce libel
2 upon the libellee including a copy of the libel shall be
3 one dollar and fifty cents.

1 SECTION 2. All legal processes including writs, libels,
2 bills in equity, wherein there is no attachment of goods
3 or estate to be made, but where service of the precept is
4 required to be made upon the defendant personally, or
5 by leaving the same at the last and usual abode of the
6 defendant, or by publication, may be made by a constable
7 within his precinct. The amount of the ad damnum
8 in any precept shall not affect such service.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
