To accompany the petition of Michael J. McEttrick that the Prison Commissioners be authorized to issue to prisoners who have reformed permits to be at liberty. Prisons.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eight.

AN ACT

To permit the Prison Commissioners to issue Permits to Prisoners in the State Prison, who have Reformed, to be at Liberty.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. If it appears to the prison commis-
2 sioners that a prisoner in the state prison, or a
3 prisoner who has been removed therefrom to the
4 Massachusetts reformatory, State farm or other in-
5 stitution, has reformed, they may recommend to the
6 governor and council that a permit be issued to him
7 to be at liberty during the remainder of his term
8 of sentence, upon such terms or conditions as the
9 governor and council shall prescribe.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
