AN ACT

Relative to the Salary and Expenses of the Sheriff of the
County of Worcester.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

- 1 The salary of the sheriff for the county of Worcester
- 2 shall be twenty-five hundred dollars, to be allowed from
- 3 the first day of January in the year nineteen hundred and
- 4 eight, and he shall annually receive his actual travelling
- 5 expenses not exceeding two hundred dollars.
