AN ACT

To authorize the Tabulation of Certain Social Statistics gathered in the Decennial Census of the Year Nineteen Hundred and Five.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The bureau of statistics of labor is
2 hereby authorized to classify and tabulate, with
3 suitable analyses, under the direction of the chief
4 of said bureau, certain data gathered at the last
5 decennial census, and relating to the occupations
6 and social conditions of the people; and the chief
7 of said bureau is authorized to expend not more
8 than ten thousand dollars in carrying out this pro-
9 vision.

1 SECTION 2. The general results of the census au-
2 thorized by chapter four hundred twenty-three of
3 the acts of the year nineteen hundred and four
4 shall be printed in four octavo volumes of the size
5 of the acts and resolves: the first and second vol-

6 umes shall contain statistics relating to population,
7 schools, libraries and the general social condition
8 of the people; and the other two volumes shall con-
9 tain statistics relating to agriculture, commerce
10 and the fisheries, etc., and statistics relating to
11 manufactures and trade; and the chief of the bu-
12 reau of statistics of labor may make such division
13 of the entire work into pages as he may deem
14 advisable. There shall be printed from electrotpe
15 plates five thousand copies each of volumes one and
16 two, twenty-five hundred copies of volume three,
17 and twenty-five hundred copies of volume four.
18 The bureau of statistics of labor shall be allowed
19 seven hundred copies each of volumes one and two
20 and three hundred fifty copies each of volumes
21 three and four, and the remainder of the edition
22 shall be distributed under the direction of the sec-
23 retary of the Commonwealth as provided by law.

1 SECTION 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsis-
2 ent herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
