

To accompany the petition of the United Electric Light Company of Springfield for legislation relative to wires and electrical appliances in said city. Mercantile Affairs.

AN ACT

Relative to Wires and Electrical Appliances in the City of
Springfield.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. During the year nineteen hundred and
2 nine, and during each year thereafter, the owners or
3 users of wires, cables, conductors and poles to which the
4 provisions of section two of chapter two hundred and
5 seventy-six of the acts of the year nineteen hundred, as
6 amended by chapter one hundred and eighty-one of the
7 acts of the year nineteen hundred and one, apply, shall
8 not be required to remove or place said wires, cables and
9 conductors underground, or to remove any poles or struc-
10 tures used in the streets to support such wires, cables or
11 conductors, in more than one mile of streets; and the
12 officer or officers named in said section, shall, in the no-
13 tice therein required to be given, limit the part of the
14 district from which such removal is to take place to one
15 mile of streets.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
