

SENATE No. 105

To accompany the petition of Patrick H. O'Connor for legislation to establish the length of vacations for certain employees of the city of Boston. Cities.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Nine.

AN ACT

Relative to Vacations for Certain Employees of the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The heads of departments of the city of
2 Boston shall provide that all persons who, for a period
3 of not less than one year, have been employed in the
4 respective departments as laborers or clerks shall be
5 allowed a vacation for a period of not less than two
6 weeks, without loss of pay, during such portions of the
7 year as said heads of departments may determine.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect when accepted
2 by the city council of the city of Boston.
