AN ACT

To authorize Heads of State Departments to dispose of
Useless Books and Documents.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. All heads of departments of the com-
2 monwealth may from time to time, in their discre-
3 tion, subject to the approval of the governor and
4 council, sell or otherwise dispose of such documents,
5 books and papers as in their judgment may be use-
6 less or of insufficient value to warrant their further
7 preservation.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
