RESOLVE

To provide for an Inventory and Appraisal of the Property of the New England Telephone and Telegraph Company.

1 *Resolved*, That the Massachusetts highway commission
2 is hereby directed to cause to be made an inventory and
3 appraisal of the property of the New England Telephone
4 and Telegraph Company, especially that part of the prop-
5 erty which is within the commonwealth. Vouchers for
6 the expenses incurred under the provisions of this resolve
7 shall be filed with the auditor of the commonwealth and
8 paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth in the same
9 manner in which other claims are paid, and he shall cer-
10 tify each month the amount of said expenses to the treas-
11 urer and receiver general, who shall assess and collect the
12 same monthly from the New England Telephone and Tele-
13 graph Company. The total expense under this resolve
14 shall not exceed the sum of thirty-five thousand dollars.
