### RESOLVE

To authorize the State Board of Health to investigate the Methods and Conditions of the Slaughtering of Neat Cattle, Sheep and Swine.

1    *Resolved*, That the state board of health is hereby au-  
2    thorized and directed to investigate the methods and con-  
3    ditions of the slaughtering of neat cattle, sheep and swine  
4    and the inspection of the products thereof and the op-  
5    eration of chapter five hundred and thirty-seven of the  
6    acts of nineteen hundred and seven and the acts in  
7    amendment thereof and in addition thereto, and report  
8    the result of its investigation to the general court on or  
9    before January fifteenth next, with such recommenda-  
10   tions as said board may deem advisable.
