Bill accompanying recommendation contained in the twenty-fifth annual report of the Board of Registration in Pharmacy (P. D. No. 39). Public Health. January 6.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

AN ACT

Relating to the Conduct of the Business of Pharmacy.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. On or after the first day of January, nine-
2 teen hundred and twelve, every retail drug store shall
3 have a registered pharmacist or assistant registered phar-
4 macist in charge at all times when said store is open for
5 business.

1 SECTION 2. Any owner or owners of a drug store who
2 violate the provisions of this act shall be liable to a fine of
3 not less than fifty nor more than one hundred dollars.

1 SECTION 3. Upon more than one conviction in a court
2 of competent jurisdiction of the violation of this act, the
3 board of registration in pharmacy may suspend the cer-
4 tificate of registration of the violator for such term as the
5 board may determine.
