Bill accompanying sixth recommendation of the Chief of the District Police (Pub. Doc. No. 32). Public Service. January 9.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

AN ACT

Relative to the Compensation of a Clerk in the Boiler Inspection Department of the District Police.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter five hundred and
2 twenty-two of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and
3 six, as amended by section one of chapter four hundred
4 and ten of the acts of the year nineteen hundred and nine,
5 is hereby further amended by inserting after the word
6 "department", in the twenty-third line, the words:—
7 The salary of the first-named clerk shall increase by
8 yearly increments of one hundred dollars until it reaches
9 the sum of one thousand dollars, — so as to read as fol-
10 lows:— *Section 1.* The governor is hereby authorized
11 and directed to appoint five additional members of the

12 inspection department of the district police, who shall
13 be not above forty-five years of age. Said age limit shall
14 apply to all new appointments to said boiler inspection
15 department, but shall not apply to any reappointment
16 thereto. They shall be detailed for the inspection of
17 boilers, and shall receive the same compensation now re-
18 ceived by the present inspectors of boilers. The gov-
19 ernor is also hereby authorized to appoint one clerk, at
20 an annual salary of eight hundred dollars, to serve in the
21 said department, and four additional clerks, at an annual
22 salary of six hundred dollars each, to serve at branch
23 offices in the said department. The salary of the first-
24 named clerk shall increase by yearly increments of one
25 hundred dollars until it reaches the sum of one thousand
26 dollars, and the salary of said four additional clerks shall
27 increase by yearly increments of fifty dollars until it
28 reaches the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars:
29 *provided, however*, that such increase is approved, from
30 year to year, by the chief of the district police for the
31 efficiency and merit of said clerks or of any of them.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
