Bill accompanying the petition of John Weaver Sherman and others for legislation relative to proceedings for punishment of the violation of injunctions. Joint Judiciary. January 9.

AN ACT

Relative to Proceedings for Punishment of the Violation of Injunctions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The defendant in proceedings for viola-
2 tion of an injunction or restraining order shall have the
3 right to trial by jury on the issue of fact as to whether
4 he committed the acts alleged to constitute the said vio-
5 lation.

1 SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts in conflict with
2 the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
