**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

**AN ACT**

Relative to the Central Baptist Society of Chicopee.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section three of chapter three hundred  
2 and eighty-four of the acts of eighteen hundred and  
3 eighty-seven is hereby amended by striking out in the last  
4 two lines the words "in another lot and new church  
5 buildings for the uses and purposes of said society", and  
6 inserting in place thereof the words:— in such way as  
7 may seem best for the interests of said society, — so as  
8 to read as follows:— *Section 3.* Said society is hereby  
9 authorized and empowered to sell and convey free and  
10 discharged of all uses and trusts which may affect the  
11 same, and in such manner as it may by vote determine,  
12 the land with the church and chapel buildings thereon  
13 situated in Chicopee at the corner of Cabot and School  
14 streets, and shall invest the proceeds of such sale in such  
15 way as may seem best for the interest of said society.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
