Bill accompanying the petition of William E. Clapp for legislation to authorize the town of Danvers to furnish electricity to the Middleton Electric Light Company and others and to legalize certain acts of the town. Public Lighting. January 10.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Danvers to furnish Electricity to the Middleton Electric Light Company and others and to legalize Certain Acts of the Town.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Danvers is hereby au-
2 thorized to furnish electricity for light, heat and power
3 to the Middleton Electric Light Company, a corporation
4 organized under the laws of Massachusetts, to the town
5 of Danvers by any of its departments operating within
6 the towns of Middleton or North Reading, and to such
7 persons or corporations within the town of Middleton as
8 are at present supplied with electricity by the town of
9 Danvers, and to execute all contracts and agreements, on

10 such terms, and for such periods of time, and to do all
11 things incident to such business of so furnishing elec-
12 tricity as the town of Danvers or its electric light com-
13 mission may deem necessary or expedient.

1 SECTION 2. All contracts and agreements heretofore
2 made, and all acts heretofore done by the town of
3 Danvers, or any of its commissioners, officers, agents or
4 employees in furnishing electricity for light, heat or
5 power to any persons or corporations in the town of Mid-
6 dleton are hereby confirmed and legalized.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
