
Bill accompanying the petition of E. Bradford Gay for legislation to authorize the city of Boston to grant him a pension. Cities. January 11.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

AN ACT

To authorize the City of Boston to grant a Pension to
E. Bradford Gay.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the spirit of
2 loyalty and patriotism, and in recognition of the sacrifice
3 made both for the commonwealth and for the United
4 States, and as a testimonial for most meritorious service
5 such as the commonwealth may rightly give and such as
6 her sons may honorably accept and receive, and in consid-
7 eration of faithful services rendered to the city of Boston,
8 the said city is hereby authorized by vote of its city coun-
9 cil, approved in writing by the mayor, to place E. Brad-
10 ford Gay, a veteran of the civil war and late master of the
11 Warren grammar school of the city of Boston, upon the
12 pension roll of the city at a pension not exceeding one hun-
13 dred dollars per month.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
