AN ACT

Authorizing Towns to appropriate Money for the Employment of Nurses.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Towns are hereby authorized to appro-
2 priate annual sums not exceeding
3 dollars for the employment of district or other nurses for
4 needy persons. The said sums may be expended directly
5 by the town or may be appropriated to be expended under
6 the direction of any hospital or charitable society situated
7 in the town, or under the direction of any town officer.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
