Resolve accompanying the petition of Meyer Bloomfield for legislation to provide for an investigation into the needs and possibilities of part-time schooling. Education. January 13.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

RESOLVE

To provide for an Investigation into the Needs and Possibilities of Part-time Schooling for Working Children.

1 *Resolved*, That the board of education is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to make an investigation into the
3 needs and possibilities of part-time schooling, vocational
4 and otherwise, for working children in the commonwealth
5 between the ages of fourteen and seventeen years; and
6 that the board is directed to investigate the existing facili-
7 ties for furnishing such vocational training within the
8 commonwealth. The board is further authorized to em-
9 ploy an agent or agents to collect the necessary data and
10 information from employers and others. The board shall
11 report the result of its investigation with its recommen-
12 dation to the next general court not later than the second
13 Wednesday in January, nineteen hundred and twelve.
14 For this investigation there shall be allowed and paid out
15 of the treasury of the commonwealth a sum not exceeding
16 sixty-five hundred dollars.
