Bill accompanying the petition of the William E. Russell Club of Harvard University for legislation to restrict the use of party designations by municipal and political parties. Election Laws. January 16.

AN ACT

To restrict the Use of Party Designations by Municipal and Political Parties.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No municipal or political party shall em-
2 ploy as a party designation any word or words which
3 would lead, or tend to lead, voters to believe that it is
4 not a party.

1 SECTION 2. All acts or parts of acts in conflict with
2 the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
