

of December of such even-numbered year be received by said board from any pharmacist or assistant pharmacist so notified, said board shall strike from the register the name of such pharmacist or assistant pharmacist; provided, that at any time thereafter, any pharmacist or assistant pharmacist whose name shall have been so removed from the register may, upon submission to the board of proof satisfactory to it of his moral and physical fitness, have his name restored by it upon the payment to it of all accrued biennial renewal fees, together with a reinstatement fee of five dollars.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF HOLYOKE TO BORROW ADDITIONAL MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF INCREASING ITS WATER SUPPLY. Chap.576

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

Section 2 of chapter 659 of the acts of 1953 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "million", in line 6, the words:— five hundred thousand, — so that the first sentence will read as follows:— The city of Holyoke for the purpose of paying the necessary expenses and liabilities other than of maintenance and operation, authorized under section one of this act, may borrow from time to time within five years from the passage of this act, such sums as may be necessary not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of four million five hundred thousand dollars and may issue bonds or notes of the city which shall bear on their face the words "Holyoke Water Loan, Act of 1953".

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWNS OF MIDDLEFIELD AND PERU AND OTHER TOWNS TO FORM A REGIONAL PLANNING DISTRICT. Chap.577

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The towns of Middlefield and Peru, and such other towns as may join, are hereby authorized to form a regional planning district for the purpose of making a study of the combined area of such towns, and, with the assistance and cooperation of the division of planning in the department of commerce, to formulate a master plan for the region comprising such towns including zoning by-laws, to be voted on for adoption at an annual town meeting held in each of such towns.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF LOWELL TO PROVIDE FOR CERTAIN SCHOLARSHIPS AT THE STATE TEACHERS COLLEGE AT LOWELL. Chap.578

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The city of Lowell may annually provide for not more than ten four year course day scholarships at the
