

HOUSE No. 744

Bill accompanying the petition of Samuel Highley and another for legislation to regulate the price of gas in the city of Woburn. Public Lighting. January 16.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

AN ACT

To regulate the Price of Gas in the City of Woburn.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The price of gas at retail manufactured
2 or sold by the Woburn Gas Light Company shall not ex-
3 ceed one dollar per thousand cubic feet.

1 SECTION 2. Whoever demands or receives a price for
2 gas in excess of that herein provided for shall be subject
3 to fine or imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on the first day
2 of September in the year nineteen hundred and eleven.
