Bill accompanying the petition of John J. Flynn for legislation relative to the salaries of sheriffs who serve as jailers and masters of houses of correction. Public Service. January 16.

AN ACT

Relative to the Salaries of Jailers and Masters of Houses of Correction.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section nineteen of chapter twenty-three
2 of the Revised Laws of the commonwealth is hereby
3 amended by striking out the word "one", in said section,
4 and inserting in place thereof the word: — two, — so as
5 to read as follows: — *Section 19.* A sheriff who person-
6 ally performs the duties of jailer or master of the house of
7 correction may receive, in addition to his salary as sheriff,
8 the compensation established by law for such services, but
9 not more than two thousand dollars a year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
