Bill accompanying the petition of James F. Griffin for legislation to provide for the extension of Boylston street across the Back Bay fens in the city of Boston. Cities. January 17.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

AN ACT

Relative to the Extension of Boylston Street across the Back Bay Fens in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston by its board of street
2 commissioners, with the approval of the mayor, may lay
3 out and construct a street from the junction of Boylston
4 street and Ipswich street, across the Back Bay Fens, which
5 shall be a continuation of said Boylston street and which
6 shall connect with Boylston street in the Back Bay Fens;
7 such street shall be used for all the purposes for which
8 public streets are now used in the city of Boston.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
