## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

### AN ACT

Relative to the Payment of a Certain Sum Due George G. Adams from the County of Essex.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. In addition to the amount which the  
2 county commissioners of Essex county shall levy as the  
3 county tax, and which is to be authorized by the general  
4 court for the year nineteen hundred and eleven, accord-  
5 ing to chapter twenty-one, section twenty-nine of the  
6 Revised Laws, the county commissioners of Essex county  
7 shall and they are hereby required to add to said amount  
8 and levy the same as a part of the county tax, a sum not  
9 exceeding eleven thousand dollars for the purpose of  
10 paying to George G. Adams of Lawrence in said county  
11 the sum of nine thousand nine hundred and forty-two

12 dollars and eighteen cents, the amount found by a jury  
13 sitting in the superior court for Middlesex county to be  
14 the fair and reasonable value of the services rendered by  
15 the plaintiff to the said county of Essex as an architect,  
16 with interest from the date of the trial to the date of  
17 payment, said services being rendered by the said George  
18 G. Adams for architectural services in connection with  
19 the proposed building of a new registry of deeds and a  
20 probate court at Salem in said county of Essex, as  
21 authorized by chapter two hundred and sixty-six of the  
22 acts of A.D. nineteen hundred and two.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
