Bill accompanying the petition of Warren F. Spalding for legislation to authorize the use of schoolhouses for lectures, readings, concerts and similar entertainments. Education. January 17.

AN ACT

To authorize the Use of Schoolhouses for other than School Purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 School committees, in their discretion, may allow the
- 2 use of schoolhouses for lectures, with or without stereop-
- 3 ticon illustrations, and for readings, concerts, and other
- 4 similar entertainments. They may require compensation
- 5 for the use of the buildings, or may permit their use with-
- 6 out charge. They may make rules governing the use of
- 7 the buildings.
