

HOUSE No. 840

Bill accompanying the petition of Richard M. Cook and others for legislation to provide for an open season on pheasants. Fisheries and Game. January 17.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

AN ACT

To provide for an Open Season on Pheasants.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section one of chapter three hundred and nine of the
2 acts of the year nineteen hundred and nine is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the word "unlawful," the fol-
4 lowing: — between the fifteenth day of November and the
5 fifteenth day of October, — so as to read: — *Section 1.*
6 It shall be unlawful between the fifteenth day of Novem-
7 ber and the fifteenth day of October following, to hunt,
8 pursue, take or kill, sell or offer for sale or to have in
9 possession, a pheasant of any kind or the flesh of any
10 pheasant except as hereinafter provided.
