Bill accompanying the petition of Alfred Tewksbury for legislation to prohibit the taking of lobsters and crabs by persons not citizens of the United States. Fisheries and Game. January 17.

AN ACT

Relative to the Taking of Lobsters and Crabs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person not
2 being a citizen of the United States to take a lobster or a
3 crab in the waters of this commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. A violation of this act shall be punished
2 by fine or imprisonment at the discretion of the court.
