Resolve accompanying the petition of the Old Colony Historical Society for the preservation of an ancient monument or boundary mark between the towns of North Attleborough and Plainville. Harbors and Public Lands. January 17.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

### RESOLVE

To provide for the Preservation of an Ancient Monument or Boundary Mark between the Towns of North Attleborough and Plainville.

1 *Resolved*, That for the carrying out of the provisions  
2 of chapter forty-one of the resolves of the year nine-  
3 teen hundred and eight, the board of harbor and land  
4 commissioners are hereby authorized and directed to  
5 purchase a tract of land, half an acre in extent, together  
6 with land of ample width requisite for a driveway from  
7 the country road, to erect a wrought steel protective  
8 fence, and to take other suitable measures for the preser-  
9 vation of a certain ancient monument or boundary mark,  
10 located between the towns of North Attleborough and  
11 Plainville, formerly bounding the Massachusetts and  
12 Plymouth colonies, known as the Angle Tree monument,

13 and erected by authority of the general court in the year  
14 seventeen hundred and ninety. For the purpose of  
15 carrying out the provisions of this resolve, said commis-  
16 sion may expend an amount not to exceed five hundred  
17 dollars, being the amount provided for in said chapter  
18 forty-one of the Resolves of the year nineteen hundred  
19 and eight, and shall make a report of the work done  
20 in its annual report for the year nineteen hundred and  
21 eleven.
