Bill accompanying the petition of William P. Fowler and others for legislation to provide for the regulation of public lodging houses in certain cities. Legal Affairs. January 17.

AN ACT

To regulate Public Lodging Houses in Certain Cities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter two hundred
2 and forty-two, acts of nineteen hundred and four, regu-
3 lating public lodging houses in cities of over fifty thou-
4 sand inhabitants, shall also apply to all buildings in
5 said cities maintained for charitable or semi-charitable
6 purposes in which ten or more persons are lodged, not-
7 withstanding that no price is charged for lodging.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon the first
2 day of June, nineteen hundred and eleven.
