AN ACT

Relative to the Appointment of Administrators of the Estates
of Deceased Persons.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. If upon the decease of a person domiciled
2 in this commonwealth a will disposing of his estate is
3 not offered for probate or an application made within
4 four months after such decease, the probate court, upon
5 application by the city or town collector wherein said
6 deceased was domiciled, shall appoint an administrator.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall have a retroactive effect.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
