

HOUSE No. 906

Bill accompanying the petition of H. V. Huse for legislation relative to regulating the transportation of intoxicating liquors. The Liquor Law. January 17.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

AN ACT

Relative to Regulating the Transportation of Intoxicating
Liquors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Any railroad corporation, street railway
2 or steamboat company transacting a regular freight busi-
3 ness may transport into cities or towns not granting liquor
4 licenses of the first five classes intoxicating liquors
5 properly marked in conformity with the law and deliver
6 the same to the consignee or upon his written order at
7 their freight terminal in such city or town.

1 SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent here-
2 with are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
