### AN ACT

To abolish Party Designations on Ballots at Municipal Elections in the City of Cambridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. No ballot used at any annual or special  
2 municipal election in the city of Cambridge shall have  
3 printed thereon any party or political designation or  
4 mark, and there shall not be appended to the name of any  
5 candidate any such party or political designation or mark,  
6 or anything showing how he was nominated or indicating  
7 his views or opinions.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
