**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.**

**AN ACT**

To abolish the Boston Juvenile Court and to transfer the Jurisdiction of said Court to the Municipal Court of the City of Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Boston juvenile court is hereby  
2 abolished, and all the powers, jurisdiction and authority  
3 now vested in said court or the justices thereof are hereby  
4 transferred to and conferred upon the municipal court of  
5 the city of Boston and the justices thereof.

1 SECTION 2. All cases pending in the Boston juvenile  
2 court at the present time shall be transferred to the  
3 municipal court of the city of Boston and disposed of  
4 in that court as if originally filed therein, and no pro-  
5 ceedings shall be instituted in the Boston juvenile court  
6 after this act takes effect.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect ten days after  
2 its passage.
