Bill accompanying the petition of Carrie G. Barr for legislation relative to temporary guardians of children. Legal Affairs. January 18.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eleven.

AN ACT

Relative to the Appointment of Temporary Guardians.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. No children shall have a temporary guar-
2 dian appointed over them in any court without sufficient
3 notice to appear in said court is given to parents or parent,
4 if living, or to the next of kin, or the person in whose
5 charge the children may be.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
